



# Digi Teachers Working Online Toolkit

## Google Slides Portfolio

**WHAT:** A portfolio in the form of a slideshow

**WHY:** To report on an easy-to-use platform where both teachers and workplace can follow the development, to enhance professionalism and to give students digital skills of the future's work life

**WHO:** The students of health and welfare (16>). They already have basic digital skills.

**WHAT:** The students learn to report about their work in a professional way. The progress becomes visible, and the feeling of empowerment and professionalism grows. During on-the-job learning the staff of the workplace can check the objectives from the slideshow, and the teacher has better possibilities to follow the student's work. It is possible to utilise the portfolio later when searching for a job. For the teacher it is easy to give feedback by using the commenting tool.

**WHICH:** Google accounts

**HOW:** Start by rehearsing the use of Google Slides at school. It is possible to report the school tasks at first, so the students are familiar with the tool when entering the workplace. You can share the slideshow only with those who are concerned, but later it is possible to share it when searching for a job. [slides.google.com](https://slides.google.com)
