



Digi Teachers Working Online Toolkit

Videocall school

WHAT: Videocalls replaced F2F meetings and supported independent studying.

WHY: During COVID it was obligatory to find a way to organise structured distance teaching.

WHO: The students in preparatory training for work and independent living. The digital skills of the students varied.

WHAT: The class had a video meeting (in Google Meet) twice a day. Along with video calls, the students studied independently and at their own pace. There were also private Whatsapp calls between the student and the teaching staff.

WHICH: Students used their mobile phones - or computers if they had any. Some of the material was sent to some of the students also as paper versions.
